- Participated in a program called Citizen Scientists in Action presented by the Cook County Forest Preserve. On Wednesday, campers took a field trip to Busse Woods and learned about different science projects. They enjoyed many activities such as bird watching, coyote tracking via telemetric waves, and identification and removal of invasive plants. - Hosted and shared a presentation on an Italian monument of their choice.

- Reviewed beginning concepts of the Italian language and acquired new vocabulary pertaining to Roman numerals, the calendar, colors, weather, and shapes.
